

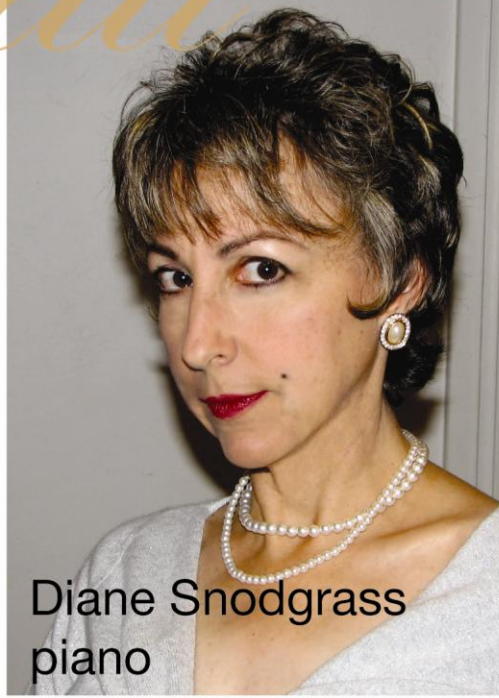

Brooklyn native **Lori Bell** is a flutist and composer of admirable depth and broad musical sympathies. A resident of San Diego, she has contributed to the development of higher standards of performance in both jazz and classical music, while earning acclaim from both peers and critics for her artistry on stage and in recordings. She received **Grammy nominations** for her work in the CD *Interplay* (1998) and *Lori Bell* (2002).

Pianist **Diane Snodgrass** appears regularly as soloist and chamber musician in the San Diego area. Recent performances include solo appearances with the San Diego Symphony, the Cabrillo Chamber Orchestra, the Classics for Kids Philharmonic, and the Opera de Tijuana. She has been actively performing the repertoire for two pianists for over 20 years and now collaborates regularly with Lori Bell and San Diego Symphony pianist Mary Barranger.
