- Please schedule class visits at least three weeks in advance.
- Class visits may include library card registration, tours, age appropriate storytimes, booktalks and research skills.

Library Cards

- At least three weeks before the class visit, come to the library or call and request applications for parents to fill out for each child.
- Before you return the library card applications to the library, please make sure that all forms have been completely filled in, includ-



ing the child's signature, parent's signature and I.D. (if available.)

- Two weeks before the visit, please return the completed applications to the library.
- Library cards are valid for two years, and may be used and renewed at any San Diego public Library.

Special Programs

Storytelling, music, magic, puppet shows, and crafts are planned throughout the year. Please make an appointment for your class for these highly popular events. Other programs can also be arranged.



Ways you can help:

- Notify the library of school assignments in advance.
- Consult with the librarian when preparing reading lists. The library may not own some of the books you require. We may be able to recommend new or special titles. The library has also developed reading lists which are available to you.
- Schedule class visits at least three weeks in advance, and let us know of your particular needs.
