

### **SB719 Quiz 3**

1. Officers ordered to terminate the pursuit should discontinue “Code 3” operation and fully abandon the pursuit once they feel they can safely do so.
2. Officers are allowed to “trail” or follow the suspect from a distance without Code 3 equipment activated after being ordered to terminate the pursuit.
3. Officers are prohibited from pursuing vehicles across the International Border into Mexico, unless the violator has committed a violent felony.
4. Pursuits are inherently dangerous for officers and the public. In order to ensure officer safety and public safety and help ensure an appropriate outcome.
5. Only Supervisors should determine who will be the contact, cover, and coordinating officers when engaging in a high-risk vehicle stop.
6. When units become involved in pursuits, only the primary officer shall request aerial assistance from ABLE.
7. Shooting at or from moving vehicles is prohibited, except when reasonably necessary to protect persons from death or serious bodily injury (DP 1.05, Firearms Procedure).
8. Any officer or supervisor actively involved in a pursuit may request
9. Any officer trained in the deployment of tire deflation devices should switch to the pursuit frequency and coordinate with the field supervisor in charge of the pursuit.
