Holiday Schedule for City of San Diego Offices and Services

ADMINISTRATIVE OFFICES WILL BE CLOSED WEDNESDAY, MARCH 31, FOR CESAR CHAVEZ DAY

SAN DIEGO – All City of San Diego administrative offices will be closed on Wednesday, March 31, 2021, for the Cesar Chavez Day federal holiday.

Trash Pickup and Disposal

Curbside trash, recyclables and yard waste will be collected as scheduled the week of March 29 for customers served by the City's Environmental Services Department. Residents in other cities should check with their waste hauler for holiday service schedules.

The City's Miramar Landfill and Miramar Recycling Center will be open on Wednesday, March 31. Refuse and recycling container sales and pick-up will be closed.

Recreational Activities

Torrey Pines, Mission Bay and Balboa Park golf courses will be open normal hours. All City skate parks will be open. City recreation centers are closed due to the COVID-19 public health order.

All public buildings in Balboa Park will be closed, including the Balboa Park Activity Center, Botanical Building, Casa del Prado, Municipal Gym and War Memorial Building. Check with other individual museums and attractions for their holiday schedules.

Hodges, Miramar, Murray and Upper and Lower Otay reservoirs will be open a half-hour before sunrise until sunset. All other City reservoirs will be closed on Wednesday. Chollas Lake will be open 6:30 a.m. to 6 p.m.

Parking Enforcement

Parking meters, time restrictions for parking on streets and yellow zones within the City of San Diego will not be enforced. Red, white and blue zones are still enforced every day. Parking rules on Port of San Diego property and in different cities may vary, please read posted signage.

Additional closures within the City of San Diego on Wednesday, March 31, 2021:

- All libraries and book pickup service.
- City pools.
- Development Services Department appointments and inspections will not be available.
- Open Space and Maintenance Assessment District Offices.
- The Testing, Employment Information Center and Background/Fingerprinting offices within the Personnel Department.

San Diego Police and San Diego Fire-Rescue emergency crews are not impacted by holiday closures.
