Solution Solution Outreach Plan

Goals for Project Outreach:

- Support on-time completion of the projects
- Inform stakeholders about the purpose and benefits
- Ensure sustained effort to inform stakeholders, by aligning communication with project phases (pre-construction, construction, completion)
- Provide ongoing, clear, consistent and timely information
- Provide stakeholders with a forum for meaningful resolution of their comments and concerns
- Respond to stakeholder inquiries and complaints in a timely manner
- Reach out to multicultural and multilingual audiences
- Tailor outreach for each project but coordinate between projects to ensure efficiency in efforts and schedule
- Ensure team consistency in communication and follow up
- Support onboarding of contractors



Structured Notification Process

- "Block by Block" approach for each new segment of traffic control
 - One-on-One Stakeholder Meetings: Two to four weeks in advance
 - Mailer: Two weeks in advance
 - Doorhanger Notification: Five days in advance
 - Door Knock/Follow-up Doorhanger: Within 24 hours in advance
 - Restoration Notice: Within five days after
 - Street Resurfacing Notice: 48-72 hours in advance

• Other notifications include:

- E-blasts
- Contact with Council offices
- Community news articles
- Social media
- Traffic advisories for the media
- Webpage updates
- Community presentations
- Nextdoor
