201. Bahia Development Plan – Consistency with the Mission Bay Master Plan

The Bahia Hotel expansion will increase the number of rooms from 315 to 600. The leasehold can increase up to 1 acre and will shift northward and eastward. Gleason Road will no longer access Bahia Point and terminate a 100 space parking lot. The displaced parking will be relocated to Ventura Cove and Bonita Cove. Plan adds a 10 foot wide pedestrian and bicycle path around the entirety of Bahia Point. A 20 x 400 foot grass strip will be added to Ventura Cove Beach area. Hotel employee and guest parking is removed from Gleason Road and will be contained 100% within the leasehold in a new parking structure adjacent to West Mission Bay Drive. The plan adds public facilities; comfort station, bocce ball courts, kayak and paddleboard lockers.

#### **Public Comment:**

- Parking spaces too far away. Need grass to go straight into the water
- Need parks and parking area.
- Plan directly harms paddlers as they cannot easily launch canoes with new plan.
- Don't remove park land.

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- Road necessary for paddlers. Impossible to carry canoes/kayaks/paddleboards through parking lots.
- Don't remove Gleason Road.
- No public access to Gleason Road is wrong.
- Don't take the parking.
- Plan inconsistent with master plan. Plan calls for preserving access needs for watercrafts. Road removal will not preserve for watercrafts.
- Master plan is advisory only.
- Lease amendment will increase at expense of public space and water craft space.
- Road is needed.
- Park is for public use not for making Bill Evans rich.
- Need room for launching area.
- Don't take away space.
- Need easy beach area access to paddleboard.
- Don't take away public access.
- Need to have workshops to plan lease amendment.
- Plan has lack of parking.
- Boards are big and heavy, need close lace to launch.
- Businesses use this access
- Against remodel.
- Area is a no wake zone. Keep this area public.
- Don't take away public land, opportunity, vehicle access, picnics, etc.
- Need parking and access
- Sand management important so keep Gleason Road open
- Children need access to water and parks.
- Don't eliminate 250 parking spots.
- Master plan out of date and recreation has changed. SUP has exploded. Usage has increased. Parking has gotten bad.
- Unique and irreplaceable parking along Gleason Road that should not be taken

A motion was made by Konopasek and seconded by Potter stating that the Bahia Development Plan is consistent with the Mission Bay Master Plan. The motion carried. (6-1-0) Mr. Green recused himself from voting.
