Commissioner Baber asked Commission staff to provide an update regarding Senate Bill 1439, which has been the subject of two recent press releases on the Commission's website. The new law is the subject of a new legal opinion by counsel for the Fair Political Practices Commission. The Executive Director summarized the status of Senate Bill 1439 in response, and provided more detail during Item 7.

Item 7: Executive Director Comment

The Executive Director noted that this is the Commission's busy training season: The Executive Director and the Commission's Education Program Manager, Ryan O'Connor, co-taught a live ethics training course for the Mayor's staff and the City's new Chief Operating Officer this week. She thanked Ryan for his excellent presentation. They will now be meeting with each City Council member and their staffs, teaching individual ethics law classes for each office in the coming weeks. In late January, they will also be teaching the quarterly ethics course for unclassified City employees.

The Executive Director provided an update on Senate Bill 1439, which has been the subject of two recent Commission press releases.

She also noted that Investigative Program Manager Kristina Gagné represented the office this week at the annual conference of the Council on Governmental Ethics Laws.

The Executive Director let Commissioners know that the gift limit for those filing Statements of Economic Interests will be increasing to \$590 in January 2023. She noted that the City's campaign contribution limits will soon be indexed, as required by local laws, and will likely be changing in 2023. The City Clerk will be reviewing the limits.

Finally, she thanked Commission staff for their work related to the 2022 election cycle, which has just concluded. She noted that fundraising may begin on January 1, 2023 for candidates in the 2024 election cycle.
