

- Over 45 new joint use facilities in the next 5-10 years.




# Background

## Audubon Elementary School

This project provides for the design and construction of a new joint use facility at Audubon Elementary School.

Located at 8111 San Vicente Street within the Skyline-Paradise Hills Community, Council District 4

Will provide approx. 2.13 acres of population based park land.



# Project Scope

Design and construction of improvements including multi-purpose natural turf field, walking track, drinking fountain, fencing and trees. The off-street parking area will also be included in the joint use area.

  - Security lighting and cameras will be added. Gates will be locked at dusk


# Public Input Process
