Citywide Security Agreements Overview

- This was a consolidation of **<u>existing</u>** security services throughout the City.
 - This was not an increases in security services
 - This agreement can be utilized on an as-needed basis for future needs as log as it is within not-to-exceed amounts by vendor.
- Participating departments include; Parks and Recreation, Library, City Treasurer, Development Services, San Diego Police and Facilities.
- Eight (8) proposals were submitted to the City and evaluated for:
 - Responsiveness
 - Qualifications and experience
 - Compatibility of proposal with City specifications
 - Cost



Citywide Security Agreements Overview Cont'd

- Contracts heard at Budget & Government Efficiency Committee on April 10, 2019 (Item No: 1)
- Contracts approved by City Council on May 20, 2019 (Item 204).
- Contracts awarded to two (2) service providers:
 - Allstate Security Services (\$24.9 M over five years)
 - Able Patrol & Guard (\$1.9 M over five years)
- Consolidation of existing services in this agreement will produce annual cost savings of approximately \$64k for the Parks and Recreation Department.

Citywide Security Agreements – P&R Locations

- Gate Closures at Community Parks I and II Divisions Skate Parks:
 - Linda Vista, Carmel Valley, Rancho Penasquitos, Robb Field, Bill and Maxine Wilson, Charles Lewis and Park de La Cruz
- <u>Gate Closures at various Community Parks I and II Divisions</u> <u>Parks</u>:
 - Soledad Natural Park, Alcott Elementary, Charles Lewis, Marie Widman, Montgomery-Waller, Palm Ridge, Silver Wing and Mount Hope Cemetery.
- <u>South Mission Beach Parking Lot and Mission Bay Park Mobile</u> <u>Patrol</u>
- <u>Balboa Park</u>:
 - Administration Building, War Memorial Building, Central Mesa, Morley Field, and Comfort Stations
- Other Facilities Managed by Parks Staff:
 - 24/7 Armed Guard 202 C Street (exterior of City Administration Building)
 - Rose Canyon Yard
 - Urban Village Mid-City Park (Patrolling)

Citywide Security Agreements - Additional/Future Security Needs

- Currently 19 of 41 security contract services are under this agreement
- As existing security contracts expire, or future security needs arise, P&R locations can be added onto Citywide Security Agreements
 - Must fall within same scope of work
 - Play all Day Joint Use Sites (gate closures)

Citywide Safety Network

- City departments, police, and private security
- San Diego Police Department facilitation of site assessments
- San Diego Police Department assisting with private security company oversight
- Communication between guards, officers, and staff
- Agreements foster a safety network
- Reduces the number of calls made to emergency services, freeing up the SDPD and SDFD resources
