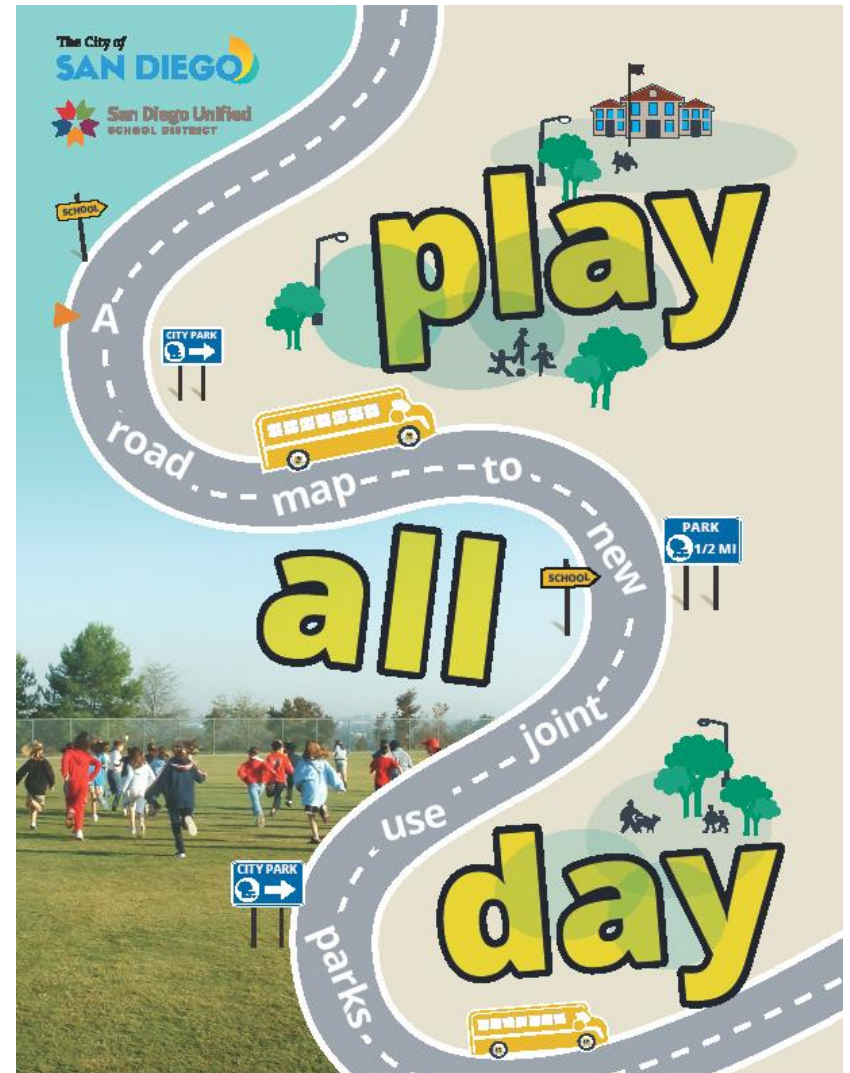

- Over 45 new joint use facilities in the next 5-10 years.



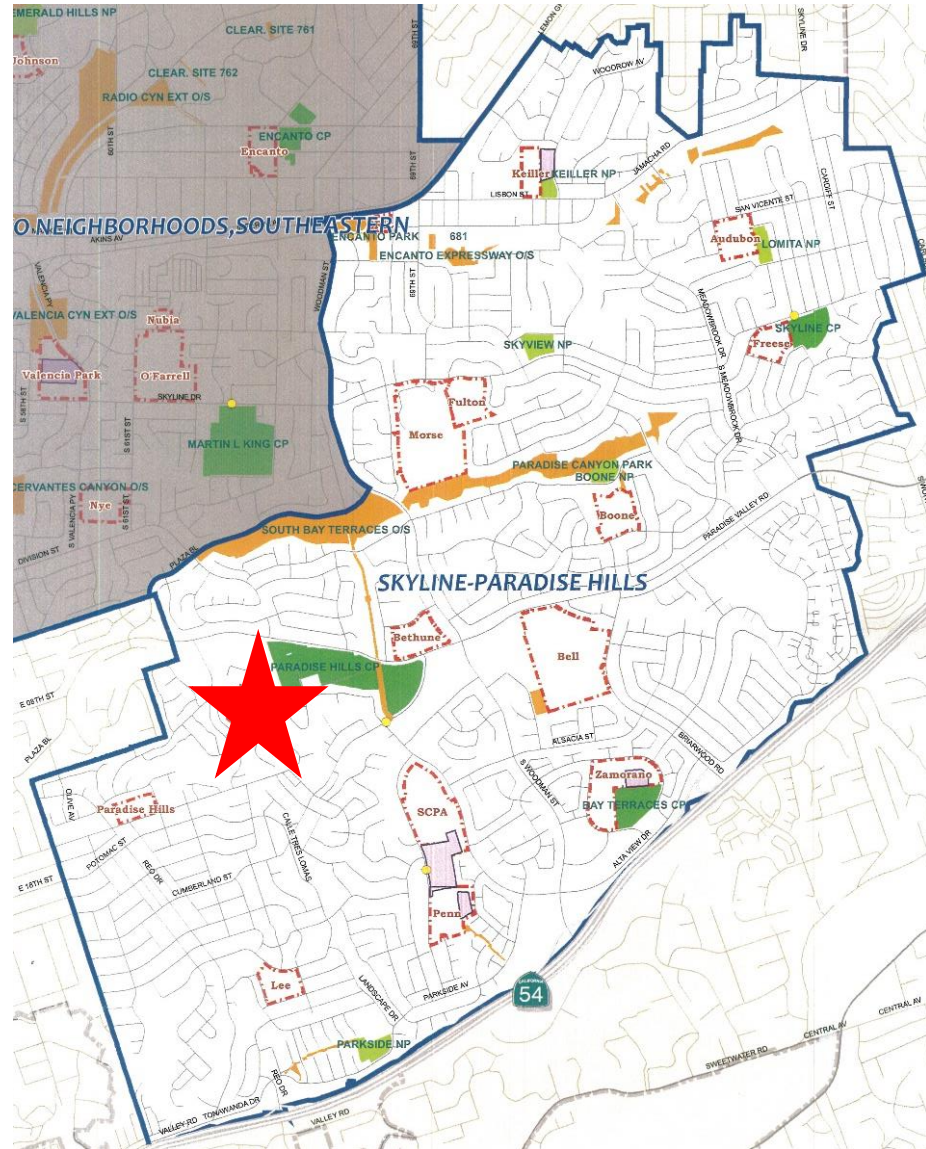
Background

Located at 6290 Orskany Road within the Skyline-Paradise Hills Community, Council District 4.

Will provide approx. 4.24 acres of population based park land.

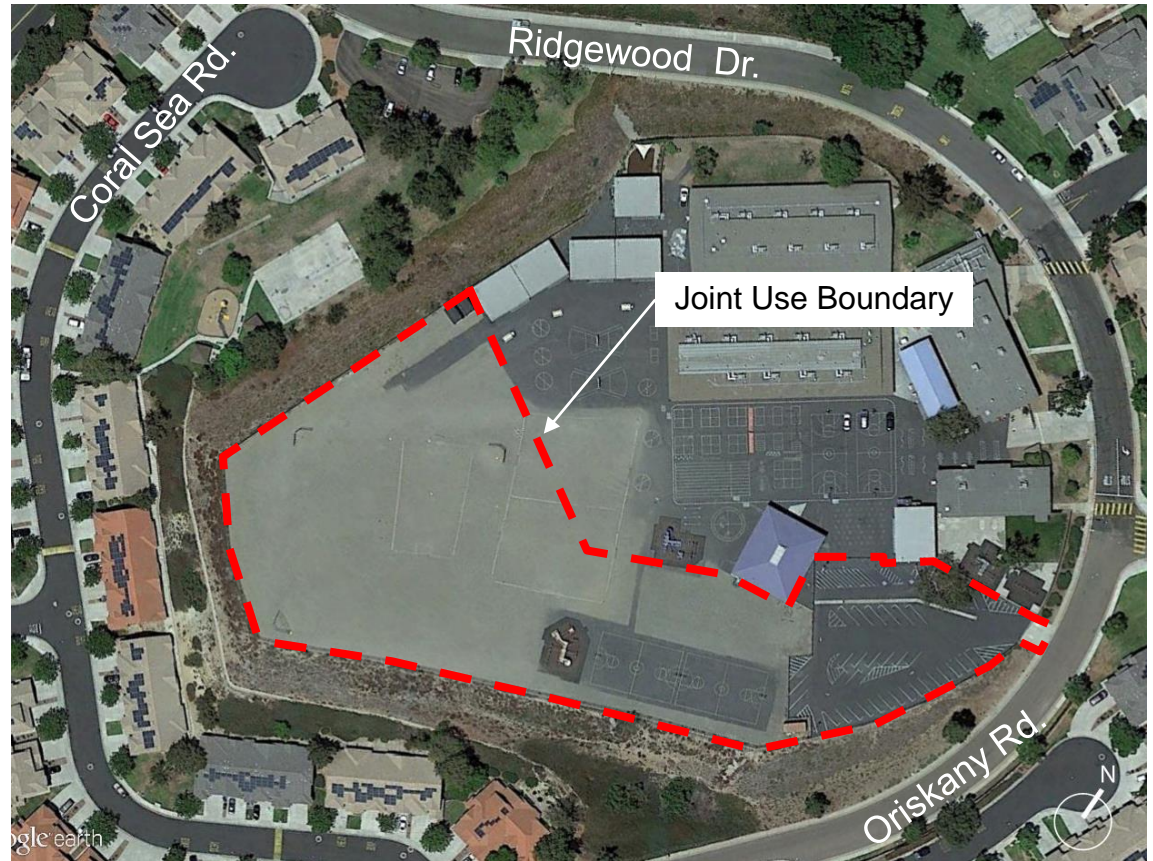


Project Scope
