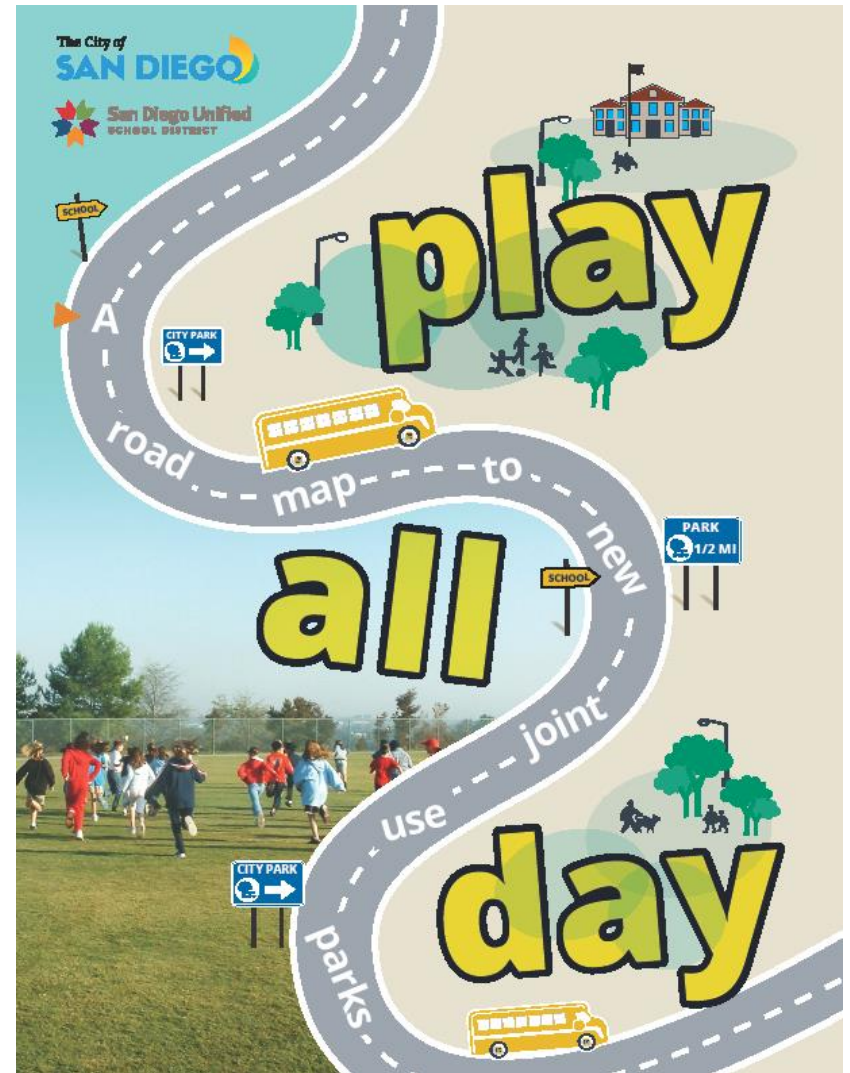

- Over 45 new joint use facilities in the next 5-10 years.





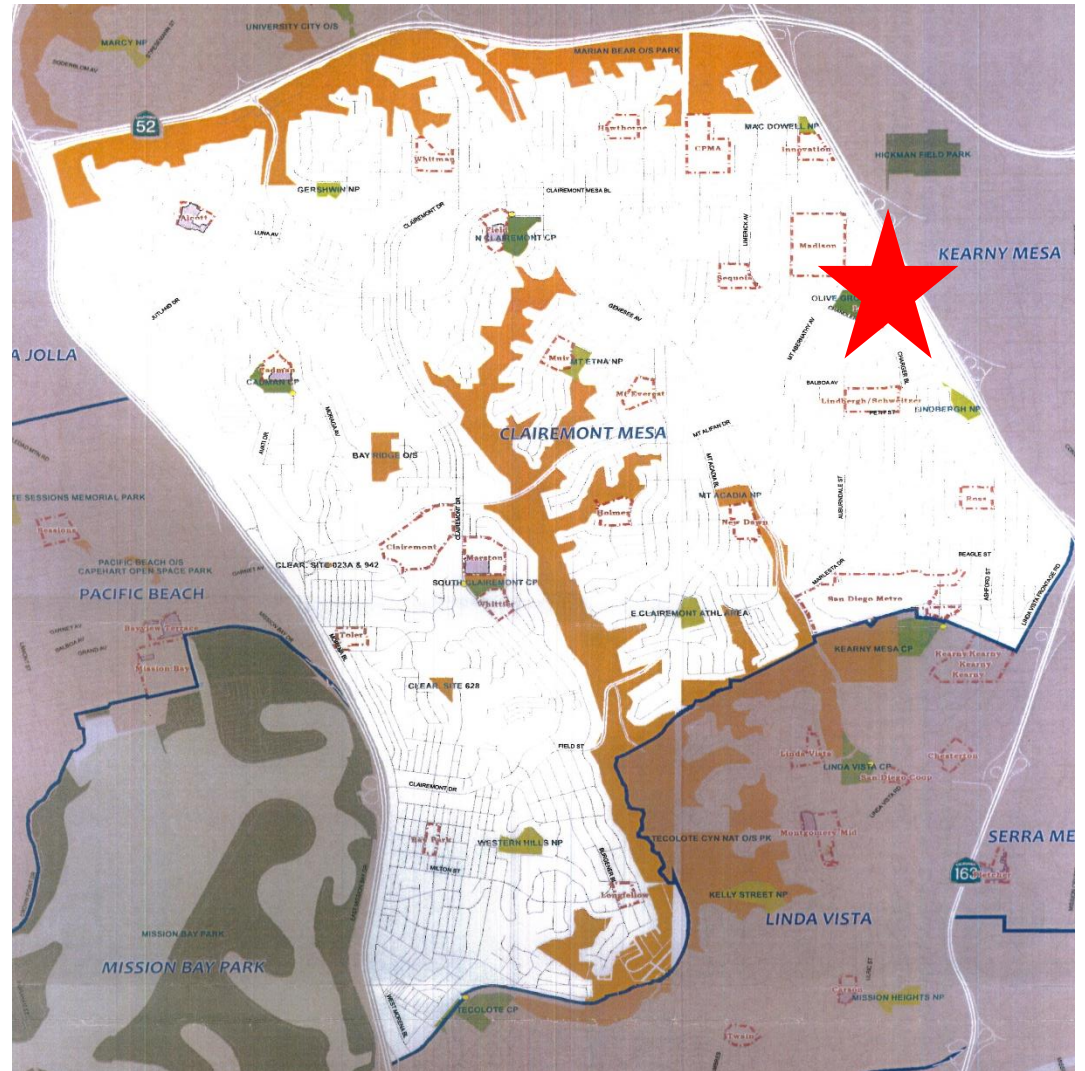
Background

Lafayette Elementary School

This project provides for the design and construction of a new joint use facility at Lafayette Elementary School.

Located at 6125 Printwood Way within the Clairemont Community, Council District 6.

Will provide approx. 4.95 acres of population based park land.

Design and construction of a multi-purpose natural turf field, walking track, drinking fountain, fencing and trees.

San Diego Unified School District various Capital Improvement Bond Program measures.

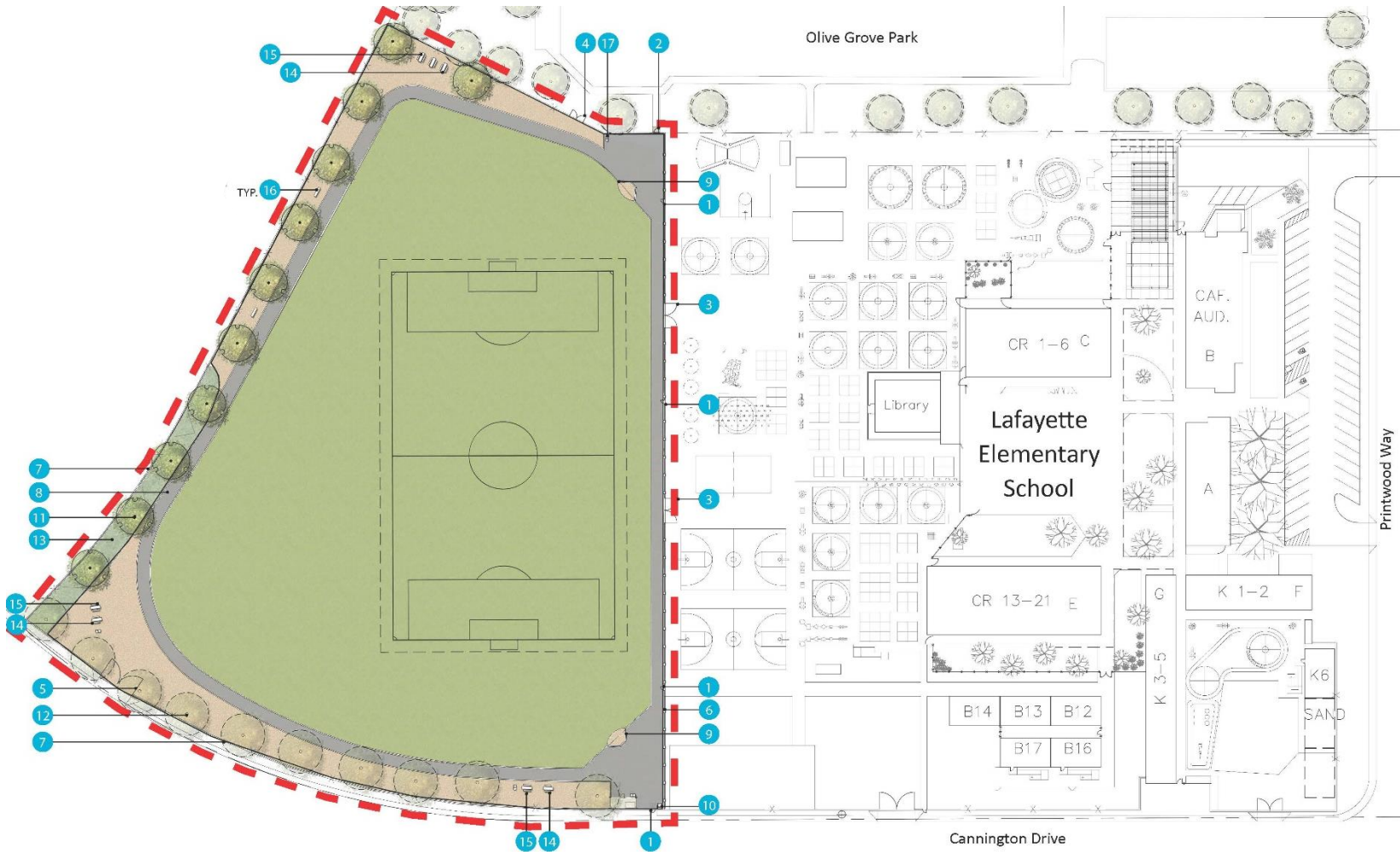

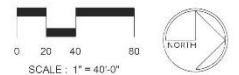


Concept Plant Schedule:
