

NOTES:

- 1. WHERE THE LENGTH OF THE PEDESTRIAN ISLAND CUT-THROUGH IS:
 - A. 8'-0" OR MORE, THE DETECTABLE WARNING TILES SHALL BE 3'-0" IN DEPTH.
 - B. 6'-0" AND GREATER BUT LESS THAN 8'-0", THE DETECTABLE WARNING TILES SHALL BE 2'-0" IN DEPTH.
 - C. LESS THAN 6'-0", DETECTABLE WARNING TILES ARE NOT REQUIRED.
- 2. DETECTABLE WARNING TILES SHALL BE PLACED AT THE EDGES OF THE PEDESTRIAN ISLAND CUT-THROUGH AND EXTEND THE FULL WIDTH OF THE PEDESTRIAN PATH OR CUT-THROUGH LESS 2" MAXIMUM ON EACH SIDE TO ACCOMMODATE FORMWORK FOR 6" WIDE RETAINING CURBS.
- 3. THE PLACEMENT OF THE DETECTABLE WARNING TILES ON PEDESTRIAN ISLAND CURB RAMPS SHALL BE IN COMPLIANCE WITH CURB RAMP STANDARDS.
- 4. THE ACCESSIBLE ROUTE OF THE PEDESTRIAN ISLAND SHALL BE CONCRETE SIDEWALK PER CITY STANDARDS.
- 5. THE CROSS SLOPE OF THE ACCESSIBLE ROUTE FOR THE PEDESTRIAN ISLANDS SHALL BE A MAXIMUM OF 1.5%. ENSURE NO PONDING OCCURS WITHIN PEDESTRIAN ISLAND CUT-THROUGH.
- 6. THE ALIGNMENT OF THE DOMES OF THE DETECTABLE WARNING TILE SHALL RUN PARALLEL TO THE DIRECTION OF THE PEDESTRIAN TRAVEL TO THE CURB RAMP ACROSS THE STREET.
