We hope you enjoyed your visit to beautiful Mission Bay, and thank you for helping keep our waters clean and safe. If you need to dump, please follow these guidelines to avoid unintentional contamination.

RV Dumping Tips:

- Use only designated dump stations. Never dump into the curb, gutter or sand.
- Connect to sewer with the correct size hose, and an airtight connection
- Dump black water first and then gray water, as it helps clean the hose
- For rinsing, carry an extra hose and never use your freshwater hose to rinse
