AWARD-WINNING WATER CONSERVATION-THEMED CHILDREN'S ARTWORK FEATURED AT HEAD TO TOE WOMEN'S EXPO

SAN DIEGO – The City of San Diego has partnered with the Head to Toe Women's Expo to sponsor an art exhibit featuring water conservation-themed artwork created by children. The award-winning art will be on display from 10 a.m. to 6 p.m., April 8, 9, and 10, at the Del Mar Fairgrounds Exhibition Hall.

The artwork is the best of the nearly 3,700 posters created by students for the City's Annual Water Conservation Poster Contest last year.
