CITY HALL UPDATES

We've got funding!



Of the \$15.9M, District 8 received \$4.26M in funding for parks from the Citywide Park Development Impact Fee program, the most of any district! Previously, DIF funds could be spent only in the communities where the fees were collected, allowing parks in wealthier areas to receive more funding. This is great news for our district as one of my main priorities is to ensure that every resident in District 8 has equitable access to parks & rec resources!

The City of San Diego received \$15.9M in funding for parks following City Council's approval this month of Citywide Park Development Impact Fee (DIF) allocations. The Citywide Park DIF program was established in August 2021, as part of an update to the Parks Master Plan. Such allocations include land acquisitions, improvements to existing parks and new construction!

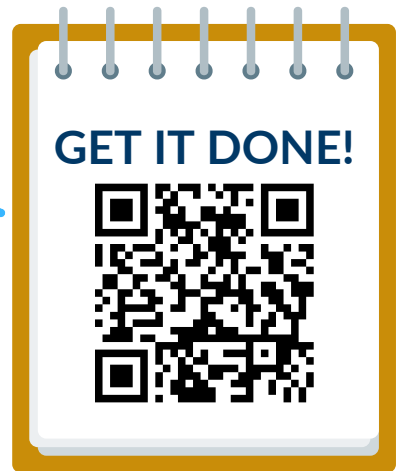
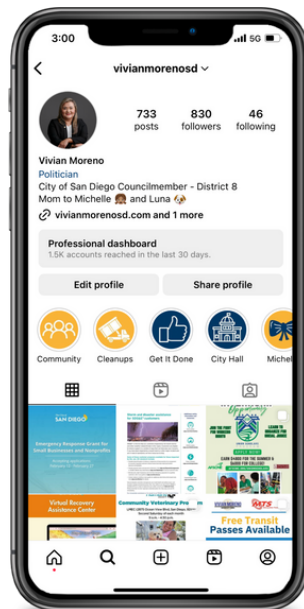
