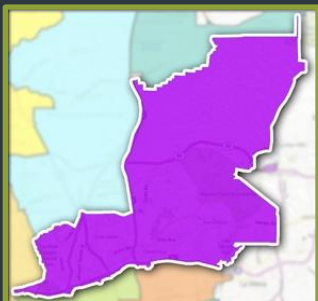

Team Sherman In the Community

On July 27, Councilmember Sherman had the opportunity to work with the San Diego Chapter of Habitat for Humanity on a project in National City. Councilmember Sherman and staff spent the day building the back and side fences for a current Habitat project. The time they contributed to the project helped complete the necessary first steps for enclosing and protecting the property as remaining portions of the project are completed. Habitat for Humanity relies almost completely on volunteer work from individuals and groups like our office. It was an honor to work alongside Habitat for Humanity and give back to the community of San Diego.



Funds Awarded to the Mission Trails Park

The Mission Trails Regional Park Foundation will be receiving Community Enhancement funding from the County of San Diego for Fiscal Year 2013-14. On June 25, the County Board of Supervisors voted unanimously to adopt the County's 2013-2014 budget, which included a \$2,500 grant to the park foundation from Supervisor Jacobs's Community Enhancement Budget.

The park foundation also received funding from the Transient Occupancy Tax (TOT) which was identical to the \$5,000 grant they requested last year. The foundation plans to use the money to hire a marketing and outreach consultant to promote the park to promote the annual children-oriented Explore Mission Trails Day.

Allied Gardens Pool Closure

The Allied Gardens pool will be closed beginning September 13 and is expected to reopen on January 19, 2014. The closure is necessary to complete ADA upgrades that are needed at the facility. For a list of other community pools in the City please click on the following [link](#).

This is the first of two public meetings with the Linda Vista Community to develop a program and an amendment to the General Development Plan for the proposed skate park. The Design Team will be presenting the location, overall site context, opportunities and constraints, and typical park amenities for a skate park. Members of the community are invited to this meeting to provide input on the proposed project.

D7 Citizen of the Month - Lara Webster

Councilmember Scott Sherman proclaimed July 31, 2013 “Lara Webster Day” in San Diego. Lara Webster is a fixture of the Sky Hunters program in San Diego County and has volunteered hundreds of hours to this cause. During Lara’s 6 years with Sky Hunters she learned how to properly handle the raptors, administer health checks, safely trim beaks and talons, and assisted with relocations. Lara enjoys sharing her knowledge of the native raptor species and has participated in over 45 events; which include five programs at the Mission Trails Regional Park and the facility’s Open House during the annual Alpine Sage and Songbird Festival. Lara has volunteered over 800 hours of service throughout the past 6 years to Sky Hunters while also becoming a licensed falconer. Lara plans to continue her work with raptors when she attends the University of Puget Sound in the fall by pursuing a special major in Biology. In recognition to the outstanding service that she has provided to the community, Lara is the District 7 Citizen of the Month.
