- I. <u>Call to Order</u> Commissioner Jason Whooper called the City of San Diego (City) Commission for Arts and Culture's Policy & Funding Committee to order at 8:06 a.m. at the office of the Commission for Arts and Culture (Commission), Civic Center Plaza, 1200 Third Avenue, Floor 9, Suite 924, San Diego, California 92101.
- II. Non-agenda Public Comment
 - Peter Comiskey (Balboa Park Cultural Partnership) thanked Executive Director Jonathon Glus and Commissioner Poutré for attending the Balboa Park Cultural Partnership Board meeting and for Glus attending the recent San Diego Regional Arts and Culture Coalition event honoring him.
- III. <u>Chair's Reports</u> -
 - A. ACTION November 9, 2018 Meeting Minutes Commissioner Jason Whooper initiated discussion on this item. Commissioner Franck requested inclusion of more details on minutes. Executive Director Glus stated he would consult with Deputy City Attorney on guidance for minute preparation. Commissioner Bossler mentioned the importance of minutes allowing for enough information to reference the actual content of meetings. B. ACTION – November 15, 2018 Special Committee Meeting Minutes – Commissioner Jason Whooper initiated discussion on this item.
