

Unknown Suspects Wanted for Felony Hit and Run

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

January 13, 2017

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the drivers of several vehicles that struck and killed a pedestrian in the Linda Vista area.

On September 11, 2016, at about 10:30 p.m., a woman was walking across the southbound lanes of the 7600 block of Linda Vista Road, when she was struck by a vehicle. She was then struck by two more vehicles. All three vehicles fled the scene. The victim died of her injuries.

Evidence left at the scene revealed that the first vehicle that struck the victim sustained a broken front, left, driver side turn signal. It belonged to an unknown color 1985-1986 Toyota Camry.
