Police Investigate Suspicious House Fire in Fox Canyon Neighborhood

San Diego – At approximately 4:20 a.m., the San Diego Police and Fire-Rescue Departments responded to a report of a house fire on Wightman Street. The residence is home to San Diego County Board of Supervisors Chair Nathan Fletcher and former State Assemblywoman Lorena Gonzalez.

Officers performed evacuations and traffic control while firefighters extinguished the fire. Fortunately, no injuries were reported.

Investigators from the San Diego Metro Arson Strike Team (MAST) were called to the scene. MAST is comprised of specially trained investigators from both the San Diego Police Department and the San Diego Fire-Rescue Department.

It is very early in the investigation. MAST is in the process of collecting evidence and locating witnesses. This morning's fire is being treated as suspicious in nature.
