San Diego Police Department is investigating two residential burglaries

The SDPD Robbery Unit is investigating two residential burglaries that share similarities and are possibly related. One crime occurred in Sorrento Valley and the other in Rancho Penasquitos. In both cases, three suspects entered the homes and initiated a burglary. In each case, the suspects entered via a side door with no signs of forced entry. In each case, the victims were awakened by the suspects and a confrontation occurred. In each case one of the suspects produced a handgun and demanded the victim's cooperation in completing the crimes.
