VICTIM IDENTIFIED IN THE SUSPICIOUS DEATH IN THE ROLANDO NEIGHBORHOOD

On Saturday, February 4, 2017, at approximately 2:50 a.m., San Diego Police Communications Center received a call to an apartment building on the 4600 block of 63rd Street regarding a male who had apparently fallen from his 4th floor apartment.

When San Diego Police Department officers arrived on scene, they found an unconscious 25 year old black male in the courtyard. The male was bleeding from an apparent injury to his head. The male was transported to a local hospital where he was pronounced deceased. The victim has been identified, as Untyuan Smith of San Diego.

During the investigation, two males were contacted inside Smith's apartment. They were identified as Smith's 23 year old roommate Ahmed Parr and 24 year old Brady Cronin. Parr was arrested for an unrelated felony probation warrant and Cronin was arrested for three misdemeanor arrest warrants. Both were booked into San Diego County Jail for the above warrants. Neither were booked on any charges related to Smith's death.

Smith, Parr, and Cronin are not San Diego State University students.

The circumstances surrounding Smith's death is still considered suspicious and the investigation is ongoing.
