SAN DIEGO POLICE INVESTIGATE SHOOTING IN THE JAMACHA/LOMITA NEIGHBORHOOD

On Saturday, February 11, 2017, at approximately 4:30 p.m., San Diego Police Communications Center received a call of a shooting at a residence on 1100 Armacost Road.

When San Diego Police Department officers arrived on scene, they found a 26 year old male, a 39 year old female, and a 47 year old male with multiple gunshots wounds to their bodies.

All were transported to a local hospital where the 26 year male was pronounced deceased. The female is in critical condition and the 47 year old male is expected to survive his injuries.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. Investigators will likely be at the scene through-out the night. At this time, investigators do not believe there are any outstanding suspects related to this incident.

All three adults have been identified, but their names will not be released pending family notification.
