POLICE IDENTIFY VICTIM IN LINCOLN PARK HOMICIDE

On Wednesday, March 9, 2016, at 7:20 p.m., the San Diego Police Department received a 911 call of a shooting in the area of 4900 Manomet Street in the Lincoln Park Community.

When officers arrived, they located a 38-year-old male on the south side of the street. The male had sustained major trauma to his upper body. Medics responded and attempted life saving measures. The injured male was transported to a local hospital where he died a short time later. A second male was struck by gunfire but his injuries were not life threatening.

Preliminary investigation revealed that an unknown person described as a 6'3" African American male wearing a dark hoodie sweatshirt and dark pants stepped out of a late 90's model burgundy Honda Accord type vehicle and fired several rounds at the victims. The vehicle fled eastbound on 4900 Manomet Street.

The decedent has been identified as 38-year-old Johnnie HORNE of San Diego.
