Unknown Suspects Wanted for Grand Theft and Credit Card Fraud

Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

March 30, 2016

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Western Division are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate two unknown suspects wanted for grand theft and credit card fraud.

On March 21, 2016, at approximately 11:45 a.m., two unknown suspects worked together while inside the Whole Foods Market located at 711 University Avenue, in San Diego. Suspect # 1 distracted the victim who was shopping inside the store while Suspect # 2 took the victim's purse from her shopping cart. The victim's credit cards were then used at Target to make fraudulent purchases. Investigators believe these suspects may be involved in similar cases in the area.

Suspect's Description: *Both suspects are described as Black females, between 30 to 40-years-old, with medium builds, and long dark colored curly hair.*
