Who Murdered James Arberry?

\$1,000 Reward Offered

March 27, 2018

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit are asking for the public's help in finding the person(s) responsible for murdering James Arberry one year ago.

On March 23, 2017, at approximately 10:50 p.m., San Diego Police Officers responded to the 3500 block of Ocean View Boulevard for a report of a shooting. Officers arrived at the scene and located 48-year-old James Arberry lying in the street. Arberry suffered multiple gunshot wounds and was pronounced deceased at the scene.

The preliminary investigation revealed that an unknown suspect described as a Black male wearing a dark grey sweatshirt and khaki pants ran up to Arberry and shot him after Arberry exited a nearby store.

Investigators are asking for anyone that has information or was a witness to this homicide, to please contact them.
