# Who Murdered James Arberry?

## \$1,000 Reward Offered

March 27, 2018

**San Diego County Crime Stoppers** and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit are asking for the public's help in finding the person(s) responsible for murdering James Arberry one year ago.

*On March 23, 2017, at approximately 10:50 p.m., San Diego Police Officers responded to the 3500 block of Ocean View Boulevard for a report of a shooting. Officers arrived at the scene and located 48-year-old James Arberry lying in the street. Arberry suffered multiple gunshot wounds and was pronounced deceased at the scene.*

*The preliminary investigation revealed that an unknown suspect described as a Black male wearing a dark grey sweatshirt and khaki pants ran up to Arberry and shot him after Arberry exited a nearby store.*

*Investigators are asking for anyone that has information or was a witness to this homicide, to please contact them.*
