San Diego Police Department Northeastern Division Detectives asking for the public's assistance.

On April 5, 2016 at about 3:30 p.m., a 10 year-old female and 7 1/2 year-old male were walking home near Jerabek Elementary School. While walking on 10500 Scripps Trail, a Jeep driven by a male suspect followed them. The Jeep stopped in front of the juveniles and waited for them to pass. After the juveniles passed, the suspect continued his actions by stopping in front of them multiple times as they continued to walk before exiting the Jeep. The suspect attempted to grab the male but the female pushed him away. The suspect also tried to grab the female, but both juveniles ran up a nearby hill to get away. The suspect returned to his Jeep and fled. The Jeep is a faded black mid-90's model Jeep Cherokee. The picture on the left is of the actual suspect vehicle taken from surveillance footage. The vehicle on the right is not the suspect vehicle but depicts the correct make/model. The suspect was described as a white male who stood around 5'5 - 5'8 with dirty blonde hair and a left eye that was described as having unusual characteristics. The suspect wore a white t-shirt, camouflage pants and red and white shoes.
