- I. <u>Call to Order</u> Commissioner Janet Poutré called the City of San Diego (City) Commission for Arts and Culture's Executive Committee to order at 9:31 a.m. at the San Diego Concourse-Silver Rooms 250-2, 202 C Street, San Diego, California 92101.
- II. <u>Non-agenda Public Comment</u>
 - Peter Comiskey (Balboa Park Cultural Partnership) invited the Commissioners to the 6th Annual Trustees event for Balboa Park Cultural Partnership on March 14, 2019. Mr. Comiskey mentioned that Balboa Park is taking a leadership position in the cultural districts program. They have launched a group called the California Cultural Districts Coalition with the hopes of bringing the districts together.

Staff is working on new locations for meetings of the Commission and its committees for the coming months. He asked that Commissioners be patient as meetings are moved. Staff is working on getting the Commission meetings recorded and posted on the City website. Onboarding of staff is continuing with the hopes of two new hires in the next six weeks. Advocacy Day in Sacramento is April 23, 2019. Commissioner Rebecca Smith shared reminded her colleagues that the arts, culture and creativity are an important tool for solving societal challenges. Glus replied that, regarding the homelessness issue, staff is exploring how to responsibly and positively respond, and he welcomes ideas from Commissioners. Commissioner Franck recommended inviting arts/culture organization contractors to connect with the residents. Chair Poutré recommended asking what help is needed.
