Attempt Murder suspect sketch and vehicle



On Sunday, April 17, 2016 at approximately 11:45 a.m. at 1700 Euclid Avenue, a 40-year-old man was set on fire as he spoke to another male near the bed of this truck. The suspect then entered this pick-up and left the Rite Aid parking lot believed to be heading north. The victim suffered severe burns and is not expected to survive.

Suspect Description: The driver of the listed vehicle is a Hispanic Male between 30-40 years of age and weighing 160-170 lbs. He was wearing a red hat, red shirt and black pants when he was speaking to the victim.
