### **HOMICIDE DETECTIVES INVESTIGATE FATAL VEHICLE COLLISION IN CORRIDOR**

Just after 10:00 a.m. this morning, San Diego Police responded to a call of a pedestrian involved vehicle collision in the west alley of 4100 Wilson Avenue in San Diego. Police, Fire Department and Medics arrived and they located a Hispanic female under a vehicle with extensive injuries to her upper body. Emergency personnel were able to pull her out from underneath the vehicle and administered first aid. Despite diligent efforts, the female died at the scene. San Diego Police Traffic Officers were called to investigate the collision. After gathering witness statements and assessing the scene, it appeared the driver of the vehicle intentionally drove into the female.

The Homicide unit was called to investigate the incident since it appears the vehicle was used as a weapon to kill the victim. Two Hispanic males in their 20's and a Hispanic female possibly covered in blood fled the scene of the incident on foot by running southbound in the alley. Homicide detectives are currently interviewing residents in the area and collecting evidence from the collision scene. The west alley of 4100 Wilson Avenue will be shut down for at least another four hours while detectives conduct their scene investigation.

The victim's identity is not known at this time.
