INFORMATION SOUGHT ON THE 16 YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF ANDREW MOORE'S MURDER

\$56,000 Reward

April 26, 2016

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit continue to look for leads in the unsolved homicide of Andrew Moore. September 8, 2016 will mark the sixteen year anniversary of Andrew's death.

The crime occurred on September 8, 2000. Andrew Moore, a San Diego City College student, was murdered in his apartment on Eighth Avenue in San Diego. As part of the crime, his 1994 Suzuki Katana motorcycle was stolen. The motorcycle was recovered on October 17, 2000, in the 1100 block of 24th Street. San Diego Police Department homicide detectives have not yet identified the suspect(s) in this case and are asking for the community's assistance.

Every year Andrew's parents fly from Pennsylvania to San Diego to present a student at San Diego City College with a scholarship in Andrew's name.

Mr. and Mrs. Moore will be available for interviews today at 11:30 A.M. at San Diego Police Department Headquarters, located at 1401 Broadway.

Anyone with information on the identity or location of the suspect(s) responsible for this murder is asked to call SDPD's Homicide Unit at (619) 531-2293 or the Crime Stoppers anonymous tip line at (888) 580-8477. Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward and the Moore family has offered an additional \$5,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest of the suspect(s). The Governor's office has offered a \$50,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to the arrest and conviction of the suspect(s).
