Unknown Suspects Wanted for Felony Battery Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

May 26, 2016

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Northern Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating four unknown suspects who were involved in a felony battery in the Mission Beach area.

On May 21, 2016, at approximately 2:30 a.m., three male suspects and a female suspect were involved in an argument with two other males in the 700 block of San Luis Rey Place, in San Diego. The two male victims ran from the group but were caught by the suspects. While both victims were on the ground, the suspects repeatedly kicked and punched them in their heads. One of the suspects jumped into the air and landed both of his feet on top of one of the victim's head, rendering him unconscious. All four suspects fled the scene before police arrived. One of the victims suffered a brain bleed and concussion.

Suspect # 1 is a White male, early 20's, 5'10" to 6'0", normal build, brown hair, full beard, wearing a burgundy t-shirt, light colored pants, and black shoes.

Suspect # 2 is a White male, early 20's, 5'10" to 6'0", thin build, brown hair, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt, long sleeved white t-shirt, black shorts, and black shoes.

Suspect # 3 is a White male, early 20's, 5'10" to 6'0", thin build, brown hair, wearing a black hooded sweatshirt with "High Times" written on the back, brown pants, and black shoes.

Suspect # 4 is a White female, early 20's, thin build, wearing a light colored t-shirt and black shorts.
