SUSPECT IN 2006 SOUTH SAN DIEGO MURDER ARRESTED

On April 3, 2006, Willie Clark Jr. was shot and killed at the “La Vuelta Bar” located at 768 Hollister Street in South San Diego after a disagreement. San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called out to the scene to investigate the incident. During the investigation, detectives learned another man was beaten with a gun and other patrons of the bar were assaulted as well. Detectives identified Guillermo GONZALEZ-NUNEZ as the suspect and he was believed to have fled to Mexico after committing the murder and other assaults. An arrest warrant was issued for GONZALEZ-NUNEZ.

On May 27, 2016, members of the U.S. Marshals, San Diego Fugitive Task Force, took custody of Guillermo GONZALEZ-NUNEZ from Mexican Authorities who arrested him in Mexico and delivered him to the San Diego Police Homicide Unit. At 7:35 p.m., 41-year-old Guillermo GONZALEZ-NUNEZ was booked without bail into San Diego County Jail for one count of Murder, one count of Attempt Murder and two counts of Assault with a Semi-Automatic Weapon. He is scheduled to be arraigned on Tuesday, May 31, 2016, at the South Bay Superior Court.
