Victim Identified In Logan Heights Neighborhood Homicide

San Diego—On Saturday, June 24, 2017, at 11:57 p.m., the San Diego Police Department Communications Center received a 911 call regarding a shooting in the area of South 31st Street and Martin Avenue. The first San Diego Police Officers to arrive found a Hispanic male lying in the intersection of South 31st Street and Martin Avenue. The victim had multiple gunshot wounds to his body.

Officers began life saving measures and the victim was transported to UCSD Hospital. Despite life saving measures, the victim was pronounced deceased at the hospital. The victim has been identified as 34-year old Jose Lopez Sr. of San Diego.

During their preliminary investigation, detectives learned that Mr. Lopez was walking on South 31st Street when a vehicle stopped in the intersection. A passenger exited the vehicle and opened fired. Mr. Lopez was struck multiple times and collapsed in the street. The passenger returned to the vehicle and fled the area in the same vehicle.

Detectives believe the suspect(s) were driving a dark colored 2 door sedan with tinted windows. The suspect vehicle was last seen driving west bound on 3000 Martin Avenue.
