Search Warrants Served For Illegal Marijuana Dispensaries/Delivery Service

San Diego—On August 16, 2017, the San Diego Police Department’s Narcotics Unit served two search warrants at illegally operating marijuana dispensaries. They were located at 7920 Arjons Drive (The Healing Center) and 6790 Top Gun Street (Kush Factory). These dispensaries were not associated with each other.

The SDPD Narcotics Unit, in partnership with the City Attorney’s office, are in the process of investigating all illegal marijuana businesses including delivery services and dispensaries operating within the City of San Diego. As a result, information was gathered that led to search warrants being obtained for these two locations.

The search warrant at 7920 Arjons Drive yielded approximately 30 lbs. of marijuana, multiple types of edibles and concentrated cannabis. In addition, \$37,000 in cash and business records were also seized. Four employees were arrested and issued misdemeanor citations for sales of marijuana and operating an illegal business.

The search warrant at 6790 Top Gun yielded a small amount of marijuana, edibles, and concentrates. This dispensary was closed for renovation and directed its customers to call for delivery service. There were no employees on site when the search warrant was served. However, paperwork seized during the search warrant will be used to identify and charge the owner with operating an illegal business (dispensary and delivery service) as well as sales of marijuana.

Both investigations are on-going and further charges against other individuals associated with the businesses may be sought.
