Unknown Suspect Wanted for Attempted Armed Robbery Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating an unknown suspect wanted for an attempted armed robbery.

On August 3, 2016, at 8:30 p.m., a Hispanic male suspect walked into Adalberto's Taco Shop located at 2498 Market Street, in San Diego. The suspect told the employee at the front counter several times, in Spanish, to give him all the money. The suspect told the employee that he had a gun and lifted up his shirt several times, but no gun was seen. The employee refused to give the suspect any money. The suspect became frustrated and told the employee that he would return and kill her if he did not get the money then. The suspect ran out of the store and headed east on Market Street.

Suspect's Description:

The suspect is described as a Hispanic male, 20 to 30-years-old, 5'6" to 5'7" tall, medium build, wearing a dark colored hooded sweatshirt, tan pants, white tennis shoes, and carried a white plastic bag with him.
