San Ysidro Felony Hit and Run

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Traffic Division are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating the person responsible for colliding with a motorcyclist and fleeing the scene in the San Ysidro area.

On June 20, 2016, at 4:00 p.m., an adult male was riding his motorcycle northbound in the 300 block of Cottonwood Road, in San Diego. A dark colored car or SUV was traveling southbound in the 400 block of Cottonwood Road. That vehicle turned left onto Seaward Avenue and failed to yield to the motorcyclist. The motorcyclist tried to swerve around the vehicle, but was hit with the front of the vehicle as it was making its turn. The vehicle fled the scene immediately.

The male riding the motorcycle sustained major injuries to his left arm that required major reconstructive surgery. The suspect vehicle may have moderate damage to its front passenger side quarter panel. Investigators are also asking anyone who witnessed this incident to contact them.
