## INFORMATION SOUGHT IN THE SEVEN-YEAR ANNIVERSARY OF BRANDON ROBINSON'S MURDER REWARD OF UP TO \$51,000 BEING OFFERED

## September 16, 2016

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit continue to look for leads in the unsolved murder of Brandon Robinson. September 6, 2016, marked the seven-year anniversary of Brandon's death.

On September 6, 2009, at 8:24 p.m., a citizen reported hearing a gunshot in the Morley Field area of Balboa Park. Officers and paramedics found Brandon Robinson on the ground next to his motorcycle, suffering from a gunshot wound. Brandon died later that evening from his injury. The preliminary investigation revealed Brandon was attending a birthday party in the park when an unknown suspect fired a gun, striking and killing Brandon.

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and the San Diego Police Department's Homicide Unit are asking for the public's assistance to identify and locate the person(s) responsible for the murder. There is a reward of up to \$51,000 for information on the case. Crime Stoppers is offering a reward of up to \$1,000 for information that leads to an arrest in this case. The Governor's Office is offering a reward of up to \$50,000 to be paid based on an arrest and conviction.

Brandon's parents will be available for media interviews today in front of SDPD Headquarters (1401 Broadway) at 10:30 a.m.
