Stimulus for the City of San Diego?

City Committee to Strategize for Federal Stimulus Funding

SAN DIEGO, CA (January 20, 2009) – Just one day after the inauguration of the country’s new president, the City of San Diego will waste no time strategizing to secure federal funding for ongoing public works projects. The San Diego City Council Committee on Land Use and Housing (LUH) will tomorrow discuss how the City may benefit from the Federal Economic Stimulus Plan.

Councilmember Todd Gloria, Chair of LUH, has expressed his intention to direct investments in the City’s infrastructure in order to stimulate the local economy and put San Diegans back to work.

The City of San Diego has a number of projects already planned that are appropriate for funding. Chairman Gloria and committee members will be presented with a report on the infrastructure aspects of the Federal Stimulus Plan and will then discuss the San Diego Regional Transportation Economic Stimulus Proposal and specific City of San Diego projects.

Other items on the agenda include an update from the San Diego Housing Commission and a presentation on the process of establishing Community Gardens.
