The New Norm: Normal Street Median Improvements Begin in Hillcrest *Parking and Landscaping Enhancements will Benefit the Community*

SAN DIEGO, CA (September 28, 2009) – San Diego City Councilmember Todd Gloria today joined Hillcrest community members and City staff at the groundbreaking for improvements to the Normal Street median in Hillcrest.

The median improvement project will help address the community's parking needs and visually enhance the frequently-traveled area on Normal Street from University Avenue to Blaine Avenue.

"Hillcrest is a thriving community for residents and visitors, and the Normal Street median improvements will help address the challenge of our parking shortage near the business district," said Councilmember Gloria, who represents the area.

The project features:

- Raised median with landscaping and irrigation
- 2-hour metered angled parking zone on the east side of the median
- Upgrades to two existing pedestrian ramps
- Installation of three new pedestrian ramps
- Addition of two new disabled parking spaces

The parking meters were approved by the City Council in May 2009 and will aid Hillcrest in two ways: they will allow for more frequent turnover of spaces and 45% of the parking meter revenues will be reinvested in parking solutions in the neighborhood. Councilmember Gloria is hopeful the parking improvements will continue.

"It is critical that we implement parking management techniques like these while moving toward adding new parking spaces with surface lots or garages," said Councilmember Gloria.

The project costs \$293,250, more than half of which is being funded through the Uptown Partnership. Local parking meter revenue is being paired with City resources to make the project possible.

Construction will begin immediately and is schedule to be complete in December 2009.



Normal Street Median Improvement Project

Project Background

Normal Street between University Avenue and Blaine Avenue is a fourlane 110-foot wide street with angle parking zones on both sides of the street and an existing raised center median. The existing parking of this block primarily supports the businesses along University Avenue. While these businesses rely on a high percentage of walking customers, they are benefited by the presence and visibility of increased parking.

Project Overview

The project will demolish the existing raised median with asphalt concrete and install a new raised median with landscaping and irrigation, 15 2-hour metered angled parking spaces at east side of median, upgrade 2 existing pedestrian ramps, install 3 new ramps, and install 2 new disabled parking spaces on the east curb of Normal Street There should be minimal to no impacts to residents and businesses in the area. Construction activity will take place at the median but it is not anticipated that Normal Street will be closed or vehicular access impeded.
