**Police Investigate Homicide in Mountain View**

**San Diego** – This afternoon, just after 3:30 p.m., the San Diego Police Communications Center received multiple 911 calls regarding a shooting at 3600 Ocean View Boulevard in the Mountain View neighborhood.

When officers from Southeastern Division arrived on scene, they found a male down on the sidewalk with at least one apparent gunshot wound to his upper body. The officers began first aid, including CPR, until San Diego Fire-Rescue personnel arrived on scene. The male was transported to a local hospital, but unfortunately, he was pronounced deceased at 4:19 p. m.

San Diego Police Homicide Detectives were called to the scene and are currently investigating the incident. It is early in the investigation and little is known about the circumstances surrounding the man's death. However, detectives have learned a group was gathered in the parking lot of a convenience store just before the shooting. A light-colored car drove westbound on Ocean View Blvd and appeared to fire several rounds at the group. The car then continued westbound on Ocean View. There is no suspect description at this time. Detectives are attempting to locate evidence and any possible witnesses. Investigators are aware several people were present at the time of the incident, but scattered immediately after. Detectives would like to speak to them.

The male has been identified, however his name is not being released at this time. He is described as a 34-year-old Black male.
