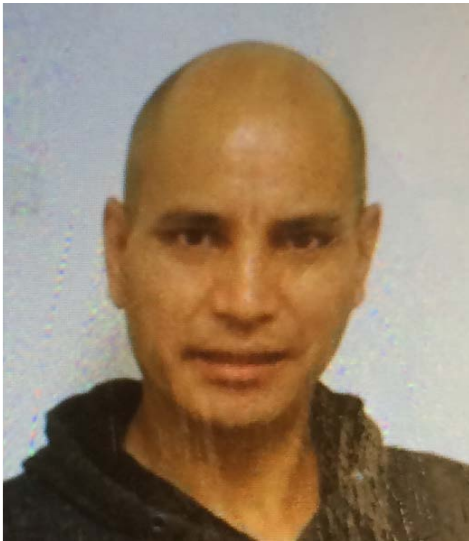

ACTUAL VEHICLE

On November 8, 2015, at approximately 1959 hours, Arline Iribre (20 year old), and her brother, Alexis Velarde (22 year old), were shot and killed behind a residence in the 1100 block of S. 43rd Street. Felipe DeJesus Vega (02/05/1976) is the suspect in both of these murders. **The murder weapon is a handgun and has NOT been recovered.**

Suspect Description: Felipe DeJesus Vega (39), DOB: 02-05-1976, 6'0", thin build.

He was last seen wearing a gray sweater, blue jeans, and white shoes, and was last seen driving a **1998 green Oldsmobile Cutlass CA/4SRJ746.**

Anyone with information on the whereabouts of Vega is asked to contact the San Diego Police Department or Crime Stoppers. If Felipe Vega is seen, **Use extreme caution. Vega is considered Armed and Dangerous.**
