Hello,

What is the reasoning for dividing University City into two districts? We have the UC Cluster of schools: 3 elementary, 1 middle, and 1 high school. One of the elementary schools (Curie) is east of Genesee and so is the high school (UCHS). The middle school (Standley) and the other two elementary schools (Spreckles and Doyle) are west of Genesee. EdUCate, a non-profit foundation that provides supplemental funds for ALL five schools since 1993 brings the UC community together each year for Oktoberfest and Taste of the Triangle. Some people divide up south UC into east and west, but it always is to the detriment of unity on issues.

If you end up dividing south UC, then you might as well move the schools and rename one of them. Please explain the rationale behind doing this. Does it improve equity? If so, how?
