To the Members of the Redistricting Commission

Using the material provided as analysis for the three maps under consideration, I noted that the SDCC map moves roughly half a million people from their current district into another. The Clairemont United Map moves a quarter of a million residents. The Chair's map only disrupts about 100,000.

The current City Council is diverse with members of various racial and ethnic groups as well as the LGBTQ Community.

Because of this wholesale disrupt, neither the SDCC nor the Clairemont United map are acceptable.

To illustrate how few members of original districts remain, I am attaching a PDF chart showing that as few as 26 % of the current district remain in the SDCC version and as few as 2/3 in the Clairemont map.

I called it the Disruption Index
