Subject: Inaccuracy in the boundaries ascribed to the La Jolla Community Plan Area

The Districtr Data Layer Tab - Community Planning Group Areas-incorrectly delineates the boundaries of the La Jolla Community Plan. As shown in attached map (unfortunately in two parts), the La Jolla Community Plan Area extends to the north of La Jolla Farms, just south of the Salk Institute.

The Districtr tool shows the northern boundary at approximately La Jolla Shores Drive with a small point a bit north. The rest is assigned to the University Community Planning Area. This is inaccurate.

This inaccuracy results in a number of errors in the HaystaqDNA reports

1. The La Jolla Planning Group area is shown in all of the three proposed maps as having a population of 29,783 and the La Jolla Neighborhood with a population of 35,926. The La Jolla Planning Group area should reflect a larger population.
2. With respect to map 72602/70727, the report shows the LJPG not split, when actually it is split between District 1 and District 6.
The report shows the La Jolla neighborhood being split. This is correct.
3. This also leads to inaccuracies in the chart showing how many Planning Group Areas are split. La Jolla should be included in the number of CPGs being split between two groups with respect to map 72602/70727.

These reports and any other conclusions in the Plan analysis should be corrected.
