

Dear Commissioners:

In developing the map #83035, HaystaqDNA has overstepped its charge and made errors, particularly in attempting to reconcile Planning Group boundaries.

Change 1 has moved 1,145 people from District 1 to District 6 putting all of Torrey Hills in District 6. This goes against all the requests from people in Torrey Hills and Carmel Valley who have asked to be kept together. These requests have been documented from the early stages of the redistricting hearings. Also presently there are uncounted written comments asking to return all of Torrey Hills to District One. This is a disservice to the process and the Commission's work. The Commission should be the one to make those decisions.

I am not familiar with the area in Change 2 and how it affects neighborhoods, but I note that 487 people have been transferred from District 2 to District 7 (not to District 6 as Haystaq DNA states)

In Change 3 it moves 210 people from District 5 to District 1, but I cannot comment on that neighborhood.

In Change 4, I can see where a correction has been made to a District 1 and District 2 boundary line in the Crown Point area, but this is not a CPG planning area boundary. That is the southern portion of Pacific Beach, not the southern edge of the La Jolla CPG area.

I hope that adjustments can be made prior to the Tuesday November 23, meeting.
