Councilmember Gloria Applauds School Anti-Bullying Proposal

SAN DIEGO, CA (April 7, 2011) – Councilmember Todd Gloria today issued the following statement about the anti-bullying policy that will be considered by the San Diego Unified School Board on April 12.
