

Suspect Wanted for Commercial Armed Robbery

Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers along with investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for the public's help in identifying and locating an unknown suspect wanted for a commercial armed robbery of a Valero gas station located in the Emerald Hills area of San Diego.

On October 2, 2018, at 1:30 p.m., an unknown female suspect ran inside the Valero gas station located at 1025 Euclid Avenue, in San Diego. The suspect ran behind the counter and pointed a handgun at the clerk while demanding money from the cash register. The clerk complied and the suspect fled the business with an undisclosed amount of cash. The suspect was last seen getting into the front passenger's seat of a newer white Toyota Corolla that drove away northbound on Euclid Avenue.

Suspect's Description:

The suspect is described as an unknown race female, approximately 5'5" tall, weighing 140 to 160 lbs., wearing a white skull mask, black hooded sweatshirt, black sweatpants and black and silver colored tennis shoes. The suspect's vehicle was a newer white Toyota Corolla with no license plates.

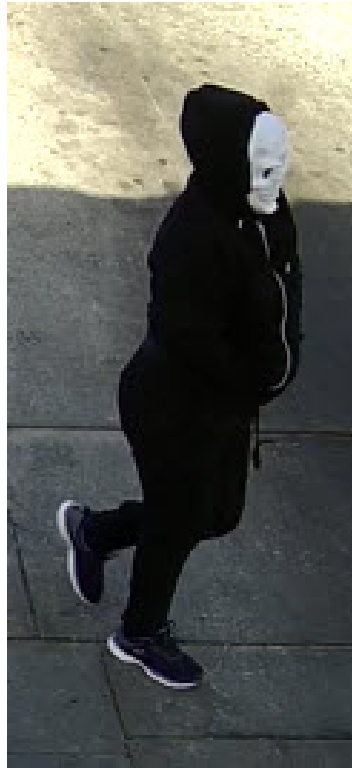
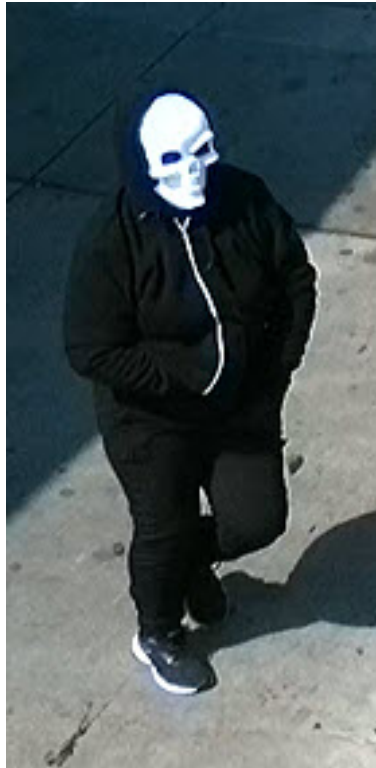
