Sketch Released of Suspect Wanted for Annoying a Child in Alpine <u>Up to \$1,000 Reward Offered</u>

December 1, 2015

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the Alpine Sheriff's Station are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate a man wanted for annoying a child.

On November 4, 2015 and November 18, 2015, a 16 year-old female was followed by an unknown Black male adult driving an older model tan Toyota Camry or similar vehicle, while she was walking in the area of Alpine Boulevard and West Victoria Drive in Alpine.

On November 4, 2015, the suspect drove up to the victim and asked her if she needed a ride to her car then, when the victim ran away, the suspect circled the block several times attempting to find her. On November, 18 2015 the suspect saw the victim as she was walking to school, then followed her to her bus stop.

The victim was not able to get a license plate on the vehicle and the suspect never got out of the vehicle.

Suspect Description: The suspect is described as a heavy set, dark-skinned Black male between 65-70 years old. He was bald but had a mustache and was wearing wire-rimmed glasses.

Vehicle Description: The suspect's vehicle is described as an older model tan Camry or similar type of vehicle.

Crime Stoppers is offering up to a \$1,000 reward to anyone with information that leads to a felony arrest in this case.
