



Unknown Suspects Wanted for Attempted Robbery Up to a \$1,000 Reward Offered

San Diego County Crime Stoppers and investigators from the San Diego Police Department's Robbery Unit are asking for assistance from the public to help identify and locate the suspects wanted for an attempted robbery at a Burger King in the Barrio Logan area.

On November 14, 2015, at approximately 9:45 p.m., two unknown male suspects walked into the Burger King located 1220 S. 28th Street, in San Diego and approached the counter. Suspect # 1 told the employee to give him the money. The employee could not understand suspect # 1 because he was whispering. The employee asked suspect # 1 to repeat what he had said. Suspect # 1 told the employee to open the register and give him the money. The employee told suspect # 1 that she did not have the register key and would need to get it from the manager. Suspect # 1 pulled up his shirt and showed the employee a handgun in his waistband. The employee retreated to the back of the kitchen area. Both suspects walked out of the restaurant without any money.

Suspect # 1 is described as a White male, early to mid 20's, 5'6" tall, weighing 150 to 160 lbs, medium build, reddish-blond hair, closely trimmed beard, wearing a red and white long sleeve plaid shirt, dark pants, tan work boots, and was in possession of a black semi-automatic handgun.

Suspect # 2 is described as a White male, early to mid 20's, 5'8" tall, weighing 170 to 180 lbs, medium build, brown hair, mustache, unshaven, black framed prescription glasses, grey short sleeve t-shirt, dark pants, and tan work boots.
